



NURSERY NEWS

Lakewood Kids is excited to announce the Nursery is REOPENING on Sunday August 30, 2020!! With such fantastic news, there are a few new things that all Nursery families need to know:

Nursery will only be available during the 9:00 worship service.

Room 2 will be for infants – toddlers.

Room 3 will be for walkers – jumpers.

There will not be a Tweeners class at this time. Kids that were in the Tweeners class last spring will remain in the nursery for now due to volunteer shortage in the preschool area.

There will be a storytime in Room 3 to help the 3 year olds get ready to move on to preschool as that becomes possible.

Parents are required to wear face coverings into the nursery for checkin and pickup. Children under 2 will not wear face coverings. Children 5 years old and under are not required to wear a face covering.

Room 1 will become a Mother's Room – a place for moms to nurse their hungry ones or to soothe their crying ones. The service will be televised into the Mother's Room so the moms won't miss service while they are caring for their babies.

Each room will have a class size of 8 children and 2 volunteers. There will be one "floater" volunteer that will be available for both rooms.

Families must preregister their child for nursery to ensure they have a space on Sunday morning. Any open spaces will be given first to visiting families, then to Lakewood families.

At check in, we will be asking if your whole family has been COVID symptom free for the past 24 hours. This is an EXTREMELY contagious virus. Little children have no boundaries with one another – they will be touching each other A LOT.

All volunteers will be required to wear face coverings – masks or shields at all times during serving.

There will be NO SNACKS SERVED in the nursery at this time on Sunday mornings.
